

## Prospectus of Study for Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program

Because of flexibility in course scheduling and differences in student needs, there is no “one way” of progressing through the CMHC program of study. For example, some students take advantage of Intersession and/or Summer courses, while others choose to take courses in the Fall and Spring semesters only. To determine the most appropriate schedule, students meet with their mentor each semester to enroll in courses. Full-time graduate student status requires a minimum of 6 credits per semester; however, students may take fewer or more credits per semester, depending upon their circumstances. Therefore, the prospectuses provided below are merely samples.
