## CPR/First Aide/AED Requirement

- Health and Safety Institute (HSI) offers training for CPR, AED, First Aid, and advanced programs such as Basic Life Support (BLS). This requirement will be met with blended and eLearning. To encourage consistency; training ensures all students learn all topics necessary to help increase survival rates.
- \*In-person skill training will be available annually in October for undergraduate 4th year students and June for 1st year graduate students.
- 1. Center for Public Safety Training is offering Heartcode BLS blended courses for University of Scranton CSD/SLP students. This course is being offered to students at a discounted rate with skills session being conducted on campus for your convenience. Students will then still complete in-person hands-on sessions and testing for courses requiring CPR and other psychomotor skills.
- 2. The hands-on session is being held on Friday, October 13, 2023, at 4:00 PM-6:00PM.
