Connecting to the University of Scranton Wireless Network

The University of Scranton's Guest Wireless Network is available in limited locations on campus. Coverage areas include Alumni Memorial Hall/Alumni Green, Brennan Hall/Founder's Green, The DeNaples Center, Hyland Terrace, McGurrin Lobby, Rupert Mayer House, Scranton Hall, and Weinberg Memorial Library/Galvin Terrace.

On Mobile/Tablet Devices

- 1. Navigate to the wireless settings on your device
 - a. iPhone: Settings > Wi-Fi
 - b. Android: Apps > Settings > Wireless and Networks > Wi-Fi Settings
- 2. Verify the Wi-Fi is toggled on
- 3. Select 'ROYALGUEST' from the list of available networks and wait for it to connect
- 4. Press the home button on your device and open your web browser app
- 5. Accept the terms of the Acceptable Use Policy to successfully finish the connection

On PC/Mac Computers

- 1. Navigate to the wireless icon 🛜 on your screen
 - a. Windows: Bottom right of the taskbar near your computer's clock
 - b. Mac: Top right of the menu bar near your computer's clock
- 2. Click on the icon to see the list of available networks
- 3. Select 'ROYALGUEST' from the list of networks and wait for it to connect
- 4. Once connected, open your web browser and refresh the page to accept the terms of the Acceptable Use Policy to successfully finish the connection
