APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Transfer Candidates Submit:

- Completed application
- Official high school transcript showing graduation date or official copy of the GED certificate and grade report
- Official results of the SAT I or ACT (if fewer than 60 college credits completed)
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended, whether or not credit was earned, and a list of courses in progress
- Personal statement
- Letter of recommendation
- Eligible-citizen applicants with permanent residency status must submit a copy of the current Proof of Residency card

APPLICATION DEADLINES

December 15: Preferred Deadline for Spring-Semester Transfer Applications

Transfer students interested in applying for the spring semester are encouraged to apply by December 15.

August 1: Preferred Deadline for Fall-Semester Transfer Applications

Transfer students interested in applying for the fall semester are encouraged to apply by August 1.

Applications are considered after preferred dates on a space-available basis.
