The intern would work in the News and Media Relations Office approximately 10 hours a week throughout the fall/spring/summer semester. This is a paid internship. The position reports to the director of news and media relations. The intern would write releases, hometown releases and media advisories, as well as assist with public relations events. The intern may also have the opportunity to work with local media covering campus events and stories. The student will gain news-clips, writing experience and learn about different functions performed in the area of public relations for the University. Students applying should have previous writing experience with student publications, such as *The Aquinas*, or other media outlets, and be recommended by a faculty member.
