- Identify core battle drills.

Develop a greater awareness of the importance of physical well-being.

- Explain the effects of stress and healthy life style on leadership effectiveness as defined in the Army Leadership Framework.

MSL 201: Innovative Tactical Leadership

Overview

MSL 201 explores the dimensions of creative and innovative tactical leadership strategies and styles by studying historical case studies and engaging in interactive student exercises. Cadets practice aspects of personal motivation and team building in the context of planning, executing, and assessing team exercises.

Focus is on continued development of the knowledge of leadership values and attributes through an understanding of rank, uniform, customs and courtesies. Leadership case studies provide tangible context for learning the Soldier's Creed and Warrior Ethos.
