

TROPICAL STORMS AND HURRICANES

<p>PREPARE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Stay informed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TROPICAL STORM EXTREME WARNING = Take Action. A Tropical Storm Extreme Warning has been issued for the University and NEPA area and may affect campus within the hour. • Monitor weather reports and Emergency Notifications ✓ Shelter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay indoors away from windows and glass doors. Go directly to a small, interior, windowless room on the lowest level not likely to flood. ✓ Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect immediately available necessities including Prescriptions, Medications, Cell Phone • Conserve cell phone battery power in the event of a power failure • Turn off propane tanks and utilities if instructed
<p>DURING the STORM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ SHELTER <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay in place unless danger is imminent (flood, electrical) ✓ Follow directions from local authorities and University ENS ✓ Stay away from: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • downed wires • floodwater, which may be contaminated with oil, gasoline, sewage • electrical appliances affected by water • structural collapse areas or other unsafe areas • dangerous debris (e.g., broken glass, metal fragments), • dead animals, or venomous snakes in floodwaters
<p>AFTER the STORM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Set up portable generators outside away from windows, doors and vents ✓ Use flashlights or battery-powered lights instead of candles ✓ If you smell or hear gas leaking, LEAVE the area and CALL 911. Don't turn lights on or off or use electrical equipment, including a cell phone ✓ Stay out of any building surrounded by floodwaters ✓ Do not to attempt to cross floodwater ✓ Building hazards may include collapse, mold, sewage or asbestos contamination
